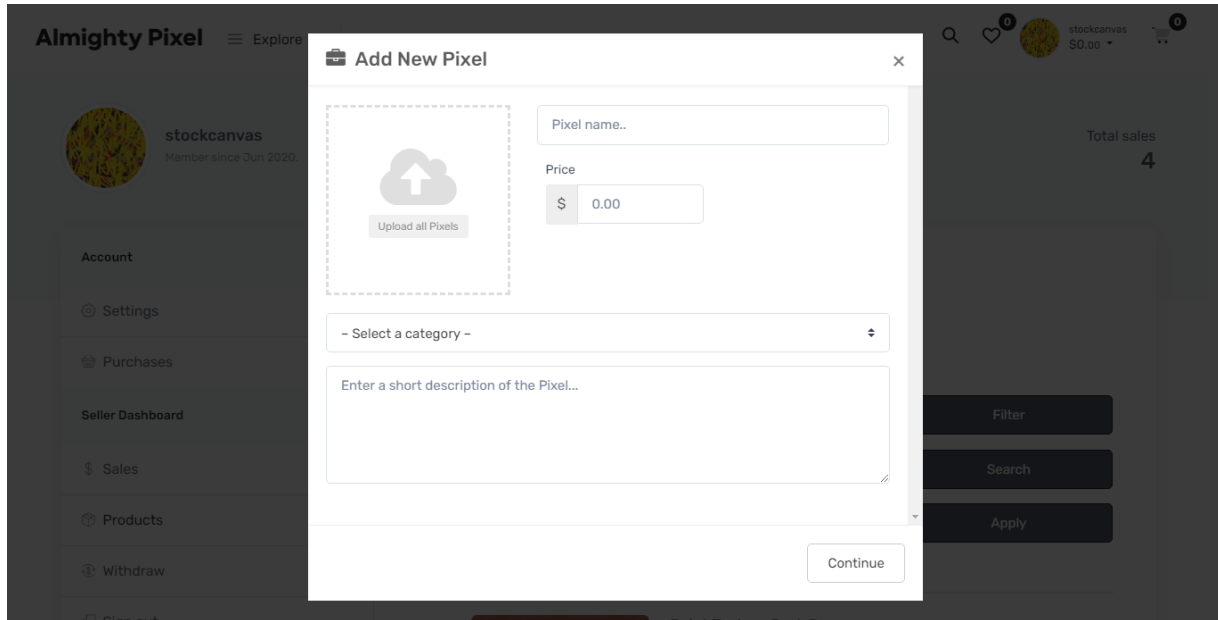


# Uploading

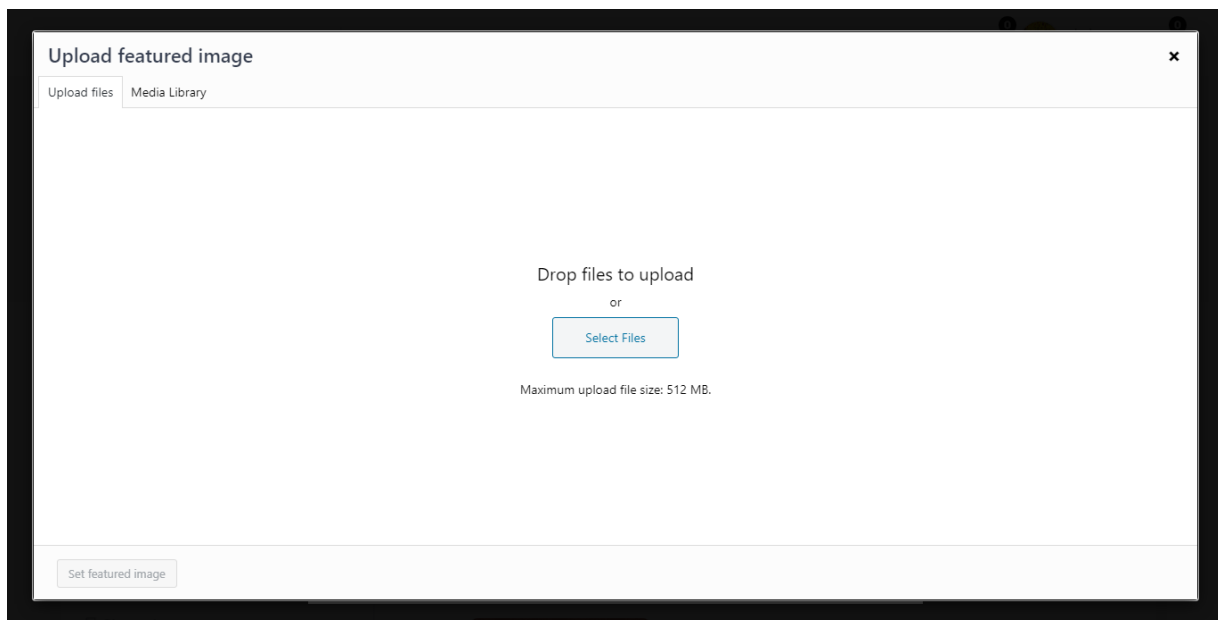
Once you're logged in to your **Dashboard**, click the **Products** menu. This will take you to the Products Page. To add, click the **Add New Product** button.

A pop-up page will appear:



Click the **Upload all Pixels** box.

Here, you will upload your Pixels – Watermark and Original – and set your featured image.



Once you've uploaded your Watermark and Original, select your Watermark and then click **Set featured image** button.

Back to the pop-up page, your featured image is now set.

Enter the **Pixel name**.

Enter the **Price**.

**Select a Category**.

Add a short description.

And then click the **Continue** button.

Now, you can set your Original Pixel.
